Environmental Policy

Luxfer Group is involved in the manufacture of gas cylinders, specialty magnesium and aluminum products and zirconium chemicals at sites in several countries. The company recognizes the real and potential impact that its activities have on the environment through emissions, discharges and by-products and the need to keep these activities under constant control and review.

To this end Luxfer undertakes to achieve the following objectives:

Organization

Luxfer Group will operate an Environmental Management System (EMS), which is endorsed by the Board. The Chief Executive of Luxfer Group is responsible to the Board for the effective implementation of this policy and for ensuring that the necessary resources are provided for its implementation.

The implementation of the EMS throughout the company will be the responsibility of all nominated Directors and Managers of the business units. Site Management will ensure that the policy is communicated to all staff. Employees will be encouraged to feel a personal responsibility for helping to ensure compliance with the environment policy and will thereby be given the opportunity to participate in environmental protection. The Group will provide adequate and on-going environmental training for staff throughout its operations in order to achieve continued environmental improvement.

The Group will introduce a system of environmental performance reporting, including reports to Board level in order to monitor environmental performance and to review environmental objectives.

Processes

Luxfer Group will comply with all legislative requirements with regard to discharges and emissions.

The Group will continue to develop processes to improve the efficient use of resources and reduce waste, including recycling of aluminum and magnesium.

The Group will seek to improve its efficiency in the use of energy and raw materials.

The Group will establish a register of environmental effects and will monitor the impact of its business on the environment.

Products

Luxfer Group will work towards continual improvement in terms of environmental impact of its products in line with national and international legislative moves toward increased producer responsibility.

Development and adherence to this corporate policy forms the central core of the Luxfer Group EMS. The policy is the driver for implementing and improving the company's environmental performance and legislative compliance. It establishes a sense of direction and sets goals for the level of overall environmental responsibility and performance required of the company, against which all subsequent actions will be judged.
